Legislative candidates for the 44th District seat, incumbent Mark Christensen and challenger and former senator Tom Baker, will participate in a candidate forum next Wednesday, Oct. 20 in Grant.

The event will be held at the Perkins County High School gym beginning at 7 p.m. MDT.
