

Joshua D. Waterman, 19, was arraigned in Perkins County Court on Wednesday, Dec. 8, on five counts of alleged theft.

Judge Edward D. Steenburg set a preliminary hearing for Wednesday, Jan. 5, 2011 and assigned Attorney George Zeilinger as counsel for the defendant.

The defendant was ordered to sign a personal recognizance bond to appear before the court in January.

Aug. 2: Alleged theft of brass impellers with a value of \$675.96, a Class IV Felony.

Aug. 15: Alleged theft of brass impellers with a value of \$2,389.50, a Class III Felony.

Aug. 24: Alleged theft of brass impellers with a value of \$300.70, a Class I Misdemeanor.

Nov. 8: Alleged theft of brass impellers with a value of \$887.40, a Class IV Felony.

Nov. 29: Alleged theft of brass impellers with a value of \$4,172.26, a Class III Felony.
