

This summer, USDA will lead the Feds Feed Families campaign with the support of the Chief Human Capital Officers Council and other agency partners, which officially begins on June 1 and will run through Aug. 28, 2013. The celebratory national kick off took place at the National Capital Area Food Bank on June 11.

Since the campaign began in 2009, Federal workers have donated and collected 15.2 million pounds of food and other non-perishable items to support families across America. Last year we collected more than 7.2 million pounds of food, and are asking agencies this year to set their own goals again and beat their previous best!
