

A free dry bean direct harvest meeting is scheduled in Grant for Thursday, Feb. 6, at the Perkins County Fairgrounds. The program will begin at 9:30-10 a.m. with sign in and coffee and conclude at 2 p.m.

Topics to be covered include: field preparation, weed control, the use of desiccants, direct harvesting, measuring and evaluating harvest loss and crop insurance considerations.

Equipment representatives will be giving an update on what is available for direct harvesting and a panel of growers will discuss their experiences and answer questions.
