

Nebraskans are invited to run a mile with the torch in the Nebraska National Guard and Air Guard, Cornhusker State Games Torch Run.

The Torch Run, sponsored by the Nebraska Army National Guard and Air National Guard, will kick off on May 3 at the Wyoming border west of Scottsbluff.

The route will cover over 1,200 miles and involve approximately 1,000 runners and volunteers as it weaves its way across Nebraska.

It will reach Lincoln, its final destination, on May 27, but won't officially end until the caldron is lit at the Games' Opening Ceremonies, on June 25 at Seacrest Field in Lincoln.

Applicants for the Torch Run will be assigned segments in one-mile increments.

Runners will be scheduled on a first-come, first-served basis.
