

Lifetime hunting, fishing, and fur harvest permits make excellent gifts for Nebraska's outdoorsmen and outdoorswomen. The recipient will have a permit valid for the remainder of his or her life.

Nebraska lifetime permits are available to residents and nonresidents. They are not valid for hunting turkey, deer, elk, antelope, and bighorn sheep.

Lifetime hunting/fishing combination permits also are available and lifetime habitat stamps and migratory waterfowl stamps are sold separately. A lifetime aquatic habitat stamp is included in the price of the lifetime fishing permit.

A holder of a resident lifetime permit may use the permit in Nebraska even in the event of moving out of the state.

Lifetime permits may be purchased online or at Nebraska Game and Parks Commission offices in Alliance, Bassett, Kearney, Lincoln, Norfolk, North Platte, Omaha, and Ak-Sar-Ben Aquarium near Gretna.
