

The Wallace Wildcats set 17 new personal best marks at the D-10 District Track Meet in Sutherland



on Wednesday, May 8.

The D-10 District included 10 schools: Sutherland, Maywood, Maxwell, Medicine Valley, Paxton, Wauneta-Palisade, Hitchcock County, Hayes Center, Brady, and Wallace.

The weather was great and many of the Wildcats took advantage, setting new personal bests. Highlights of the meet included the boys team finishing in fourth place overall, as well as three Wildcats qualifying for the State Track meet!

Hayley Storm had personal bests in both the long and triple jumps, finishing third in the triple jump, just one place shy of qualifying for State.

The top two finishers in each individual event on Wednesday qualified for state. Any additional qualifiers either made a qualifying mark in the field events or ran one of the two fastest third place times in a running event. The first place relay teams also qualified, additionally the next five fastest times from all districts qualify.

Juniors Landon Swedberg and Shane Anders finished first and second in the discus to qualify. Freshman Tanner Clough placed second in the 3200 and was the fastest third place finisher from all districts in the 1600, which qualified him in those two events.

Tanner will run the 3200 on Friday at 6:25 p.m. Landon and Shane will throw the discus at 8:30 a.m. on Saturday, followed by Tanner in the 1600 at 2.p.m.
