

Dr. Jennifer Ochsner was recently hired as the breast imaging radiologist in a new Vancouver, Wash., breast care center. The clinic expects some 15,000 women to come through the center in its first year of operation. Nationally, one in eight women will be diagnosed with breast cancer.

Dr. Ochsner, the only breast imaging fellowship trained radiologist in Clark County, leads the center's imaging team. She attended Boston University where she received her bachelor of science degree and her medical degree from the University of Cincinnati.
