

The Associations of Nebraska Art Clubs (ANAC) has 40 clubs and 770 members.

A four-day art conference comprised of workshops and a judged art show is held once a year at different cities in Nebraska. Each club is given a quota of how many of their best pieces of art may be entered at conference.

In Columbus 2011 there were 351 entries. This year the judge was Don Andrews, a nationally known artist, workshop instructor and author from Fairhope, Ala. He chose 25 pieces to receive "Certificate of Excellence" awards, including a "Best of Show."

This group of award winning pieces is called "The ANAC Travel Show: and is traveling around the state to 18 host towns.
