Plans are underway for the annual Christmas event hosted by Perkins County Chamber in downtown Grant.

This year's Christmas open house is scheduled for Thursday, Nov. 19, when businesses will remain open throughout the evening, crafters will display their wares, food outlets prepare specialties, shoppers find bargains, and Santa Claus comes to visit with the little people.

The day also kicks off the opportunity for consumers to register for the Holiday Chamber Bucks Giveaway. Each year Chamber picks cash prize winners at the luck of the draw during the month of December.

A total of 15 winners will receive \$50 in Chamber Bucks during the three drawings scheduled for the first three Saturdays in December.

In the spirit of Christmas, half of the proceeds from the fee charged to non-Chamber members to set up a table will go to the Magi Store.

**Food Offerings**

A potato bar will be held at the Perkins County Senior Center with a variety of toppings, drinks and dessert.

Restaurants and convenience stores along the street include DJ's Bar and Grill, Sally's Cafe, Bench Warmers, Kwik Stop, and In and Out.

Specialty outlets include Heaven Scent Bakery and miscellaneous offerings from a club or church along the street.

**Rules for Chamber Bucks Giveaway**

- Customers must make a purchase to receive an entry ticket.
