Siren testing was among announcements made by City Manager Tyson McGreer during the regular meeting of the Grant City Council Tuesday, April 13.

In preparing to replace the city's sirens, a company was in Grant on Tuesday of this week to see what the requirements are.

A siren representative tested sirens atop a boom on a truck at both Grant City Park and the Perkins County Courthouse, the sites where the new ones will possibly be erected.
